

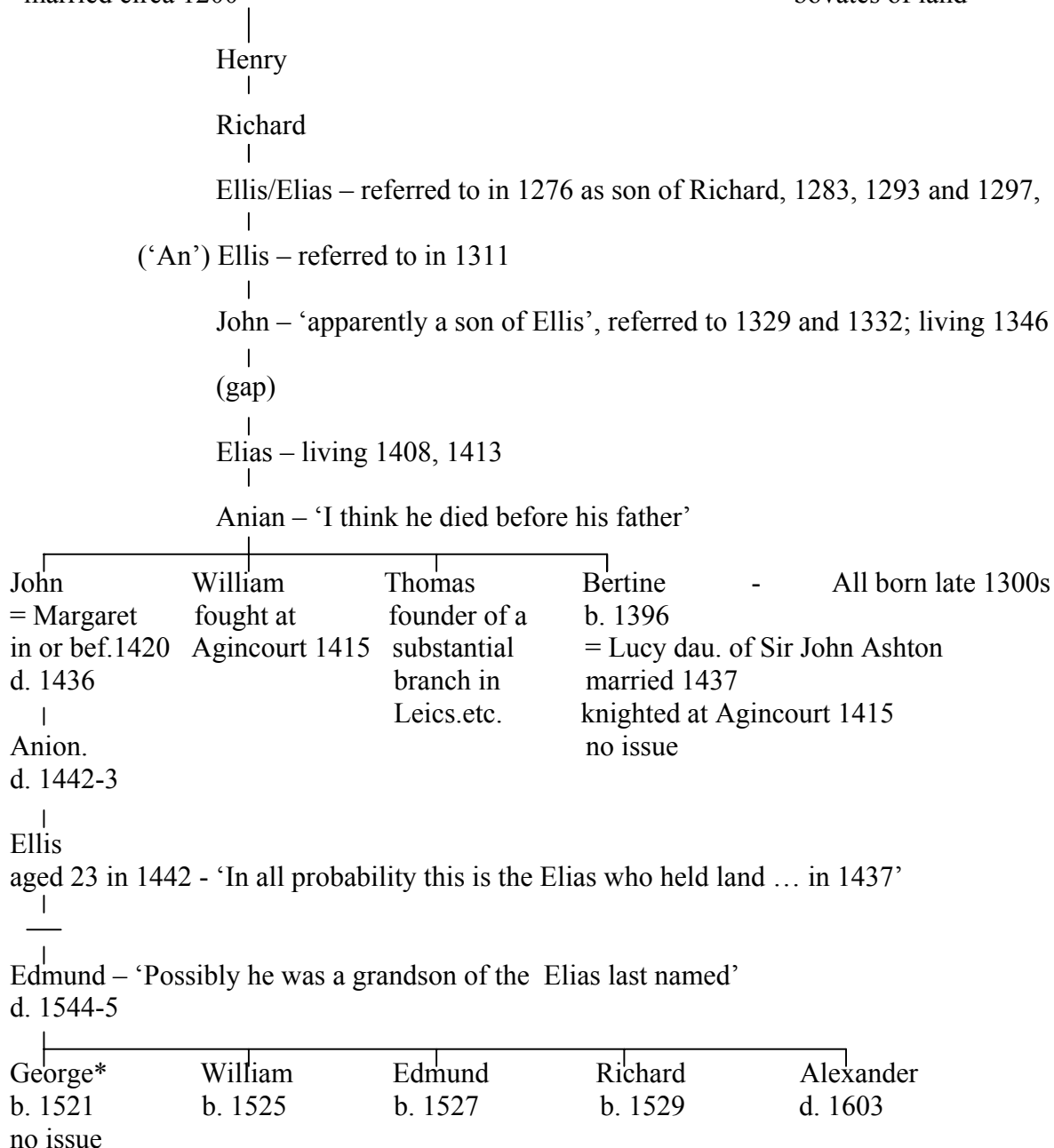
THE ENTWISLE FAMILY – Their ancestry according to B. Grimshaw
